

Driving directions to NE Fla Fairgrounds Lot: Entry at Intersection of Middle Rd and Eula B Rd Coming from the North Take I-95 Exit 373 Bare Right onto SR 200. In about 5 miles take a right onto Griffin Rd. In about 2 miles turn left to stay on Griffin Rd. In 2 miles it will become Middle RD and in about 3.5 miles the entrance will be on the right.

Coming from the South Take I-95 Exit 337 to I-295. In about 27 miles take exit 28B New Kings RD/US 1/US 23. In about 13.5 miles turn right onto Middle Rd and the entrance will be ½ mile on the left.

Coming from the West From I-10 take US 301 North. In about 20 miles in downtown Callahan turn Left on S Kings Rd US 301/US 1. In about 2 miles turn right on Middle Rd and the entrance will be ½ mile on the left.

A note about Membership!

The insurance provider for The National Council of Corvette Clubs has determined that anyone attending a NCCC Sanctioned Event must be a member of the National Council of Corvette Clubs to be covered by our insurance policy.

The bottom line is that if you come by to see what the new site is like, if something happens to you, you are not covered by our insurance or the fairgrounds'.

Only NCCC Members are covered by our Insurance and <u>everyone</u> on the site <u>must</u> sign the waiver.

Minor waivers are available but must be signed by the parent or legal guardian in the presence of the registrar.

Sorry but, NO, grandpaw/grandmaw may not sign for their grandchild!

To join NCCC, bring a check to the event for membership and another for the entry fee (cash works too).

Membership dues are \$35.00 per year for Enthusiast and \$10.00 for their spouse.

The membership check will be to NCCC, the entry to NFCA!

We will have the Region Membership Director with her lap top joining people into the National Club the morning of the event.

You may join on the day of the event but must pay with separate cash or check from the event entry fee.
