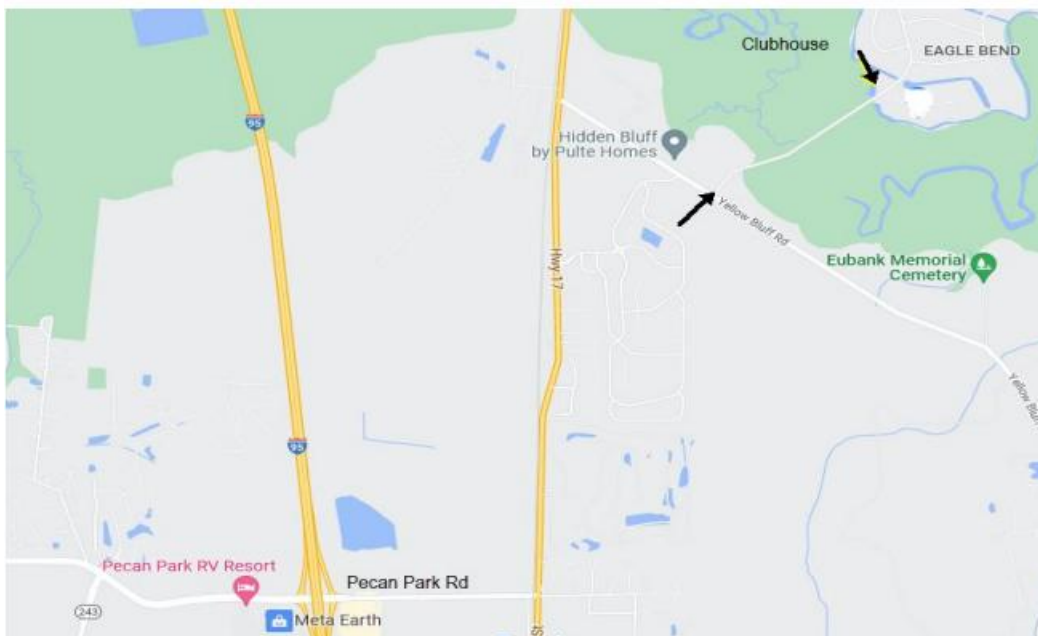
Minimum age of navigators is 16 years old
